

YMCA School's Out Vacation Program:

Advanced Registration Required

YMCA After School Program:

Our focus on youth development ensures a safe, nurturing environment for children to learn, grow and develop social skills.

This adult supervised program includes **games, special projects, sports** and more. **Homework assistance** is provided and won't interfere in the activities your child loves to participate in. A snack is provided.



Program Hours

The YMCA After School Program starts at 2:50 pm and closes at 6:00 pm, Monday through Friday when school is open. **We do not provide service at the school when school is out or on early dismissals days.** Parents picking up after 6:00 pm will be charged a late fee. All fees are detailed in the payment policy.

5 days/week \$210
4 days/week \$195
3 days/week \$170

If your child's fee is being paid for by an outside agency it is the guardian's responsibility to know their co-pay.

Payments:

Once enrolled, all payments are due by the first of each month. A \$25 late fee is due if payment is received after the 15th of the month. If no payment is received, the deposit will be used to pay for the current month and the **child will not be able to attend the After School Program on the first of the following month.** If the parent wishes to continue the service, the past due amount, a \$25 late fee and a one month tuition deposit must be paid by the first of the following month.
